IADT - San Antonio Associate degree:

American InterContinental University (AIU) agrees to accept the aforementioned IADT - San Antonio Associate degree as a block of 90 quarter hour (QH) credits towards the fulfillment of one of the following AIU 180QH Bachelor completion programs:

Bachelor of Business Administration

Bachelor of Fine Arts in Visual Communication

Bachelor of Information Technology

Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice

The following IADT - San Antonio Associate degree is separated according to its remaining requirements in any of the above AIU Bachelor’s programs. Any Associate degree program from catalogs previous to the 2009-2010 IADT - San Antonio catalog may be reviewed on a case by case basis, and are not explicitly covered under this agreement. All programs require a total of 180 quarter credit hours for graduation, including 54 quarter credit hours in general education requirements. Any Associate degrees containing less than 27 quarter hours in general education requirements will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis according to the policy outlined in the current AIU catalog.

<u>IADT - San Antonio Degrees and Remaining AIU Requirements</u>
Associate in Applied Science in Merchandising Management
Remaining Requirements to be fulfilled at American InterContinental University
Students entering an AIU Bachelor’s program under this agreement will be required to select one of the aforementioned AIU Bachelor programs of study, and successfully complete an additional 90 quarter hour credits as follows:
45QH of Upper Division Core coursework within the major area of study.
18QH of Upper Division Concentration courses relevant to the student’s program of study.
27QH of general education courses as determined by AIU’s Prior Learning Assessment department upon review of transcript.*

*If the Prior Learning Assessment Department determines that the student completed in excess of 27QH of general education coursework within their Associate degree, the courses will be evaluated on a case by case basis, and subtracted from the 54 quarter hour total of general education required by AIU Bachelor programs. These requirements will be replaced with lower level coursework relevant to the student’s field of study as determined by AIU.
