Students enrolling in a Virtual Campus Online course will be charged an Online course fee. The Online course fee includes Virtual Campus access, online library, 24/7 technical support, and all course materials, which may include e-Books, textbooks, and/or software. The Online course fee is as follows:		
Undergraduate fee per course (4.5 credits)	\$104	
Graduate fee per course (6 credits)	\$168

Although the costs of the textbooks and supplies vary according to the program, the average cost per 15 undergraduate or 12 graduate credit hours is \$400.

Refer to the Degree Programs section of the catalog for descriptions of the degree programs Program Tuition is charged per credit hour each quarter throughout the student's program and is charged at the beginning of each quarter. Custom suite of course materials for Virtual Campus online courses are provided to the student by Words of Wisdom, LLC. At the University's discretion, books may be delivered in an electronic (e-Book) or standard textbook format. Students not wishing to use e-Books are responsible for any additional charges associated with purchasing standard textbooks. Online Course Fee is charged to students taking a class through Virtual Campus. Online Course Fee will be billed after the add/drop period of each quarter. Online Course Fee waivers for the quarter (when applicable) will be subsequently applied to student statements during the aforementioned timeframe. Adjustments to Online Course Fee will not be made should there be any changes to course schedules after the add/drop period for the quarter. Textbooks purchased in American InterContinental University Bookstore will be billed to student's account. Textbook waivers for the quarter (when applicable) will be subsequently applied to student statements during the aforementioned timeframe. For all students eligible for the military tuition rate, the online course fee and textbook charge will be posted to a student's account once each quarter, after the add/drop period. The charge will then be waived, resulting in no net materials cost to the student. Students wishing to enroll under non-degree-seeking status should see the University Course Catalog for applicable information
