PHARMACY TECHNICIAN

Regulations and requirements for pharmacy technician certification, registration, and licensure vary by state and change on an undefined schedule. Some states have no requirement for technicians to register with the State Board of Pharmacy, while other states have more rigorous requirements. Some

states require pharmacy technicians to attain national certification, either as a requirement to be registered or licensed, and/or to perform certain duties.¹

<u>Licensure</u>: Those interested in this field should contact the <u>State Board of Pharmacy</u> where they are seeking employment, and before they relocate to a different state, to learn about a state's complete and current pharmacy regulations.

<u>Certification</u>: The Pharmacy Technician Certification Exam[®] (PTCE[®]) is offered through the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB). Individuals who successfully complete this exam receive the Certified Pharmacy Technician (CPhT) credential.
