OVERVIEW

AIU offers a professionally-focused BFA in Media Production degree program with a specialization in Digital Film and Post Production that is designed to provide students an opportunity to study industry-relevant knowledge and skills applicable in today's film, video and audio markets.

COURSEWORK

CURRICULUM INCLUDES

In this specialized curriculum, students have an opportunity to build an understanding of the entire process of film production, with an emphasis on screenwriting, motion-picture photography and lighting styles, and directing. For example:

Film & Audio Aesthetics: students can study how to analyze film in terms of form, structure, cinematography, editing, and use of sound and music.

Directing: students can examine the director's role in each of the three phases of film production, in order to achieve a specific vision.

Production Techniques III: students can explore either a drama or a documentary production in depth, over two consecutive terms.
