Students are responsible for purchasing textbooks and supplies required for class. Although the costs of the textbooks and supplies vary according to the program, the average cost per 15 undergraduate or 12 graduate credit hours is \$400.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Undergraduate program tuition and total program cost are based upon standard full-time program length. Standard full-time undergraduate program length is based on an average of 15 credit hours per quarter. For Associate Program, four quarters at 13.5 credits and two quarters at 18 credits = 90 credits. For Bachelor's Program, eight quarters at 13.5 credits and four quarters at 18 credits = 180 credits. Actual amounts will be based upon actual program length, which may vary due to transferred credits, or repeated courses. Repeated courses, not averaging 15 credit hours per quarter, and part-time status (taking less than 12 credit hours) will increase program tuition and total program cost.</li> <li>2. Students who graduate from the Associate Degree Programs and enroll into an AIU Baccalaureate Degree Program (other than the same program in the Baccalaureate Degree Programs) may be required to take additional courses to satisfy program requirements. Taking additional courses will increase program length, program tuition, and total program costs.</li> <li>3. Undergraduate full-time tuition cost per quarter is based on credit-hour load between 12 and 18 credits.</li> <li>4. Undergraduate students taking more than 18 credit hours during a quarter will be charged on a full-time per-credit-hour basis for all credits taken.</li> <li>5. Students taking less than 12 credit hours during a quarter will be charged on a part-time per-credit-hour basis.</li> <li>6. The undergraduate part-time per-credit-hour rate includes a tuition premium, except Criminal Justice program.</li> <li>7. Custom suite of course materials for Virtual Campus online courses are provided to the student by Words of Wisdom, LLC. At the University's discretion, books may be delivered in an electronic (e-Book) or standard textbook format. Students not wishing to use e-Books are responsible for any additional charges associated with purchasing standard textbooks.</li> <li>8. Graduation Fee includes administrative costs associated with graduation activities (ceremony, diploma, etc.). Effective Quarter 2, 2015, Graduation Fee is \$150. A non-refundable Graduation Fee will be charged to the student's account during the final term.</li> <li>9. Certificate program tuition and total program cost are based upon standard part-time program length. Standard part-time certificate program length is based on 9 credit hours per quarter. Actual amounts will be based upon actual program length, which varies due to transferred credits, or repeated courses.
